Recovering Impounded Firearms

- If a firearm was impounded as evidence, the first step in the release process is obtaining authorization from the assigned investigator.
- All persons attempting to obtain an impounded firearm are required to go through the Department of Justice Law Enforcement Gun Release Application process.
- When a firearm is eligible for release, the Gun Desk will provide the LEGR application.
- If the Department of Justice provides a Law Enforcement Gun Release Clearance letter, it is only valid for 30 days.
- An appointment is required for picking up a firearm.
