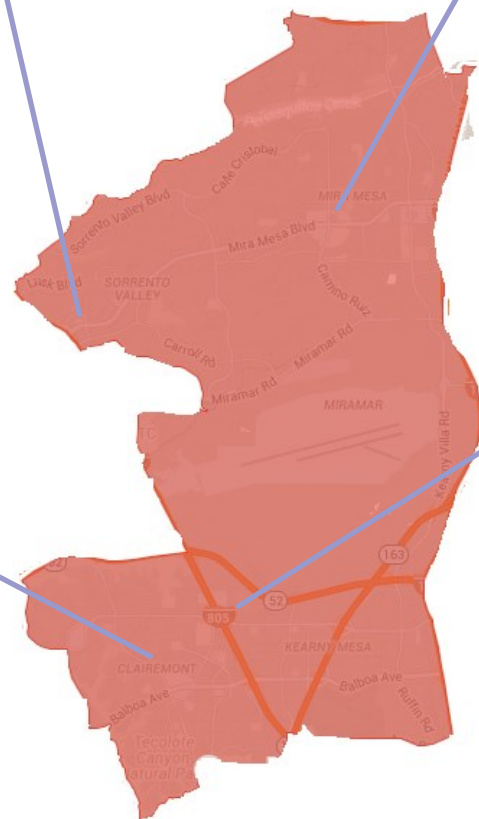

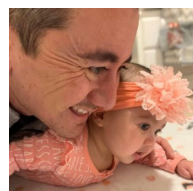
**MIRA MESA:** Thank you to the Mira Mesa Town Council for inviting me to swear in their 2019 Board of Directors.
