CATEGORY DESCRIPTION

Category 1 Investments and business positions in any business entity located in or doing business with the City.

Income and gifts from sources located in or doing business with the City.

Interests in real property located in the City, including property located within a two-mile radius of any property owned or used by the City.

Category 2 Investments and business positions in a firm or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City, receives goods or services from the City, that is a tenant of the City, that is an adverse party of the City in a legal proceeding, or that is granted authority by the City to use City facilities.

Income and gifts from any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City, receives goods or services from the City, that is a tenant of the City, that is an adverse party to the City in a legal proceeding, or that is granted authority by the City to use City facilities.

Interests in real property owned or used by any person or business entity that supplies goods or services to the City, receives goods or services from the City, that is a tenant of the City, that is an adverse party to the City in a legal proceeding, or that is granted authority by the City to use City facilities.

Category 3 Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees for the General Services Department and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest category in the code subject to the following limitation:

The Department Director may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position", is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a

description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of Interest Code.
