The City of San Diego (City) invites any interested parties to participate in the preparation of the Citizen and Community Participation Plan (CoPP).

As required by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the City must adopt a CoPP setting forth the City's policies and procedures for citizen participation. The CoPP establishes standards for the City to provide for and encourage citizens and entitlement grant beneficiaries to participate in the planning, execution, and evaluation of the HUD Program Planning Documents.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the CoPP will be available for public review at the Economic Development Department office (1200 Third Avenue, Floor 14, San Diego, CA 92101), the CDBG Program's website (www.sandiego.gov/cdbg), and select City libraries (Central, Malcolm X, San Ysidro, Logan Heights and City Heights/Weingart) and community centers (Bayside Community Center, the Jacobs Center for Neighborhood Innovation) from **August 23, 2017, through September 22, 2017**.

Following the 30-day public review period, the CoPP will be presented to the City Council for approval
