Public Services:	Employment training; veterans services; senior services; youth services; health services; homeless services; disability services; domestic violence services
Business Assistance:	Technical assistance; general business support
Public Facility Improvements:	Senior centers; homeless facilities; youth centers; neighborhood facilities; health facilities
Housing:	Rehabilitation of owner-occupied single-family housing units; rehabilitation of multi-housing rental housing units; direct homeownership assistance
Sustainability:	Improvements to increase energy and/or water efficiency
