ArtReach	92101	\$10,000	ArtReach will partner with a local artist to provide contemporary arts-focused, in-school programming at Horton Elementary. Two mural artists will lead students and community members in creative placemaking, transforming a bleak wall into a dynamic mural. An end of program culminating event will gather the school community for a mural unveiling and campus-wide art exhibition.
Intrepid Shakespeare Company	92023	\$10,000	At the San Diego Public Library in March 2020, Intrepid will inaugurate the National August Wilson Monologue Competition, a free arts education program inspiring high school students to find and express themselves through the work of Pulitzer Prize-winning playwright August Wilson. Participating students will attend free workshops guided by award-winning artists. Winners of the competition will travel to New York to perform on a Broadway stage and will have the opportunity to earn scholarships for college.
Museum of Contemporary Art San Diego	92101	\$10,000	MCASD will offer an after-school Artist Studio/Club for students at Monarch School, a public K-12 school. The Artist Studio/Club will provide an in-depth arts mentoring experience for a core group of Monarch students and engage the wider school community through Museum field trips, a youth-led Parent Night, and a culminating collective art installation on campus.
Musicians for Education	92115	\$10,000	Musicians for Education's signature program, Street of Dreams, is an arts education and college bridge program that takes place at Lindsay Community Day School and San Diego City College for 100 teen mothers who are at high risk of homelessness and entering prison. Street of Dreams Live! spoken word concert is the culminating annual event and the result of a year's worth of performance and production workshops for participating students in the Street of Dreams program.
The New Children's Museum	92101	\$10,000	The New Children's Museum will present an Artist-In-School Residency Project in collaboration with Lindsay Community School. A teaching artist will present weekly art-making sessions from November 2019 to March 2020 to teen students (grades 9-12), most of whom are expecting or have newly become mothers. A culminating exhibition in late March 2020 will display the students' artworks at a school location and celebrate Youth Art Month.
transcenDANCE Youth Arts Project	91950	\$10,000	transcenDANCE Youth Arts Project will conduct a CREATE EXPRESS CAMP for 40 King-Chavez Prep Academy students during spring break 2020. The CAMP is a proven program designed to develop social-emotional intelligence and resilience through self-reflection, community building, dance and expressive arts experiences. Teaching artists will creatively engage students to break barriers of inequality and build empathy and understanding through creative expression.
San Diego Symphony Orchestra Association	92101	\$10,000	San Diego Symphony (SDS) will partner with USD to present Mariachi at Memorial, offering 60 students: instruction in violin and trumpet by Symphony musicians and USD teaching artists who receive intensive coaching from these musicians; attendance at SDS concerts/master classes; performances at the International Mariachi Festival and to a Symphony Family Concert.
Young Audiences of San Diego	92105	\$10,000	Arts for Learning San Diego (A4LSD) will provide 12 weeks of visual art classes for 2nd and 3rd grade students at Logan K-8 school. Art classes will be integrated with social studies, to enhance student learning of the curriculum. Professional development workshops will be held for all teachers at the school. A culminating art exhibit will take place at the school and Logan Heights Library. A4LSD will also offer a Family Arts Night at the library, to engage families from the community.
