SUBJECT: Annual Evaluation and Report for Fiscal Year 2020 Citywide Grant

Activities

This *Annual Evaluation and Report* on City of San Diego grant related activities for Fiscal Year 2020 is being provided pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code §22.5205, which states:

Within 90 days of the end of each fiscal year, the City Manager shall provide Council with a written report of all initial grant applications and renewal requests that were accepted, appropriated, and expended by the City Manager during that fiscal year.

This memorandum contains information on active grant applications and awards for FY 20 through the Grant Review Team (GRT) process, in coordination between the Chief Operating Officer, Department of Government Affairs, the Department of Finance, and grant seeking and administering City departments.

For FY 20, the City of San Diego through the GRT process received a total of 45 non-pandemic related grant awards, with a combined value of \$86,494,710 from federal and state sources. For FY 20, the City of San Diego through the GRT process submitted 74 grant applications, with a combined value of \$195,086,807. Grants allotted as multi-year awards may have been initially obtained in previous fiscal years and are distributed to the City annually until the end of their grant term.

Due to the unprecedented challenges of the coronavirus pandemic this year, the Government Affairs Department and grants staff within individual departments successfully secured numerous emergency pandemic-related grants from state and federal sources to support essential City functions. Most notably, the City received a direct allocation of \$248,051,020 in CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Funds from the U.S. Department of Treasury. Other pandemic-related supplemental funding that the City was allocated through application or direct allocation is included on Attachment 3, for a total of \$291,555,850.

The Department of Government Affairs has been managing the City's grant review and coordination functions since September 3, 2019. Since that time, the department has refined and improved several key processes related to grant activities, strategic alignment, internal review, and tracking and reporting. We remain committed to further improving grant performance by growing the City's overall grant application output, which we expect will increase awarded funds to the City and its community and agency partners.

We look forward to continuing to work closely with the Council on our ongoing efforts to seek and secure grant funding.
