Gentlemen:

We are transmitting herewith proposed ordinance establishing landing places for sport fishing boats operating on the bay of San Diego.

We find that the sport fishing business is growing to such an extent that it is necessary to build additional landing places and establish areas in which the sport fishing industry can be handled. Last season we were rather cramped for sufficient float space, but our plans for next season calls for additional floats to care for the number of boats that were operating in the sport fishing business last season.

It will take about 10 or 12 floats and they will be located in the area between the Foot of "E" Street and the Foot of Market Street. The plans have all been gone over many, many times with all the men engaged in the business today, and they have all agreed that the proposed arrangement is a practical one.
