I beg herewith, to return to you, Document No. 256117, and wish to state further that the North San Diego Chamber of Commerce has not thoroughly investigated the situation or they would not ask the City to pour oil on the pools mentioned.

We have consistently stocked all the pools in that vicinity with the Gambusia minnow. Oil in the pools would kill the fish and we request that further action be left in the hands of the Health Department.
