How-To do Five Fun Things with a Blow Dryer

Instructions:

--Use as a **hair curler:** (first, cut off the top portion, about a quarter, of a medium size plastic water/ soda bottle and set aside).

Cut out a rectangular shape piece on the side of the plastic bottle, the same width as the blow dryer attachment. Insert the blow dryer attachment into the opening on the side of the bottle, then place a small handful of slightly damp or dry hair into the clean plastic bottle. Turn on the blow dryer for approximately ten seconds on high heat to curl hair.

- --Use as a vacuum to clean up small messes: insert a paper towel, napkin, or coffee filter inside the cut off top of the plastic bottle. Place over the nozzle of the blow dryer, then aim the open end of the bottle top at the mess, turn on the blow dryer to vacuum up debris.
 - --Waterproof shoes: rub candle wax over the top of shoes then blow dry on high heat until wax has melted onto shoes.
- --Remove water rings on wood furniture: point the blow dryer at an angle to the wet ring then turn on blow dryer to high heat and swivel blow dryer around the ring until dry.
- --Use as a duster: point the blow dryer at an area to dust, turn on the blow dryer to low heat and blow the area to remove dust, dirt, and debris.

Next time you use your blow dryer, just remember to give this simple, unassuming, everyday hairstyling tool a lot of credit for its multiple uses and never underestimate its SUPER POWERS!
