How-To Slime

Ingredients:

- PVA glue (commonly known as wood glue, white glue, carpenter's glue, school glue)
- Bowl
- Food coloring
- Contact lense cleaning solution

Instructions:

- 1. Put your PVA glue into a bowl. Put as much glue as you want slime.
- 2. Add your food coloring of choice, and mix it so it goes into the glue.
- 3. Add in a pinch or two of baking soda, and mix it into the glue.
- 4. Now, slowly add in your contact solution, mixing in between squirts. Keep on stirring until your glue begins to congeal. This could take 5-10 minutes.
- 5. Once your slime solution pulls away from the bowl, plop it onto a table and knead it with your hands so the "stringiness" goes away.

Now you have slime!
