

How-To Make Your Own Stickers

Materials:

Silhouette Cameo
Silhouette Cameo Accessories
Sticker Paper
Printer
Computer
Silhouette Studio Software (computer program)

Step 1: Download the Software

Go to silhouetteamerica.com and download the version of Silhouette Studio that is compatible with your computer

Step 2: Open Silhouette Studio

Step 3: Import your Image

Find the image that you want to make stickers of and drag and drop it onto the work area. Make sure that your image is in .jpeg or .png file format

Step 4: Trace the image

Open the trace panel and then click the box labeled "Select Trace Area" and draw a box around your image. The image should then turn yellow. You want the image to be a solid yellow color, so if it isn't you may need to adjust the threshold. Then select Trace Outer Edge. A red line should now appear around your image.

Step 5: Offset Trace Line

If you would like a border around your image, select the red line that is formed around your image. Then select "Offset selected Shape", this will give you a border around your image. Delete the original red line. This step is optional.

Step 6: Group the images

Select both your outline and your image then select Group Selected Shapes. This will make it easier to move things around.

Step 7: Set up Page

Open the page setup panel. Adjust the media size to the size of the paper you are using. Select the tab labeled Registration marks. Select On.

Step 8: Add images

You can copy and paste or add other images to fill up the page. If you select an image you can use the anchor points to adjust the size of your stickers.

Step 9: Print

Once you are happy with the layout of your images print the page. It should print out with the registration marks.

Step 10: Load the Cameo

Place the sticker paper you printed on the cutting mat. Load the Cutting mat into the cameo.

Step 11: Settings

On Silhouette Studio select Send in the upper right corner. Select the material that you are using, white sticker paper, and then press send.

Step 12: Unload

Once the cameo has completed cutting, select continue and then select unload.

Step 13: Enjoy!!
