

How to Crochet a Beaded Anklet

Presented for the 2021 How-To Festival by Sharon Stapp-Anderson



Supplies:

- Metallic Silver Thread 2 ply
- 10/0 Czech Seed Beads
- Soldered Ring
- Lobster Claw Clasp
- Charms
- Crochet Hook 1.6

- Super glue the end of your cord; it makes the end into a needle.
- Put beads on thread. You can guesstimate, and add more at the end, after you cut the cord. (Work on roll if possible.)
- Start your single chain crochet with three unadorned chains. (Give yourself a tail to help knot on your clasp when you are finished.)
- Pull a bead in to the next chain, and then a single chain.
- Repeat to desired length.
- End with three single unadorned chains and give yourself a tail to tie Soldered ring on.
- Tie on Lobster clasp.
- Tie on soldered ring and tie on any charms.
- Dot of super glue on knots, then cut off excess.
