

How to Braid a Double Wrapped Bracelet

Presented for the 2021 How-To Festival by Sharon Stapp-Anderson



Supplies:

- Waxed Linen
- Square Czech 8/0 Beads
- Charms
- Button (for a clasp)

Instructions:

- Cut cord into 2 pieces:
 - 1 long piece: measure twice around your wrist, double it, then add some extra length for the knots. You will thread this longer piece through the button at the cord's halfway point.
 - 1 shorter piece: this should be half the length of your first piece of cord, plus a little bit for knots. You will thread one end through the button.
- Tie a knot snug under the button with all three strands of cord.
- Start braiding with three regular braids.
- Then start adding a bead every time you pull the braid in the same direction. Essentially, you'll add a bead every other braid.
- Continue to your desired length.
- Braid three extra times.
- Tie overhand knot.
- Make enough space for button to slip through. Add Charms if you have them.
- Tie overhand Knot.
- Dot of super glue on all Knots.
- Trim off all excess.
