

How to make wall hanging using old/recycled cds and dvds.

Supplies needed:

- 1. Blank cds or dvds 4**
- 2. Permanent markers**
- 3. Cardboard or cereal box strips about 5 inch**
- 4. Scotch tape, glue or glue sticks, scissors**
- 5. Paper circle cutouts about the size of the disc (magazine paper, notebook paper or blank printer paper can be used)**
- 6. Sequence, glossy wrapping paper, or peel and stick gems.**
- 7. A piece of yarn, satin ribbon or twine about 10 inch**

Instructions:

- 1. Take a cd or dvd disc and draw a pattern or design on it of your choice
Such as flowers and leaves, butterflies, shapes etc. you can use a permanent marker to draw it.**
- 2. Use permanent markers to color your patterns. (After coloring is done, you can outline your pattern in order to make it look brighter or give it a nice finishing touch.**
- 3. Attach discs using cardboard or cereal box strips and scotch tape.
(Strips should not be too thick or too thin. I used cereal box strips which worked well. You can use other kinds of boxes in order to cut the strips such as pasta boxes or cookie boxes as well.)**
- 4. Glue circle cutouts on the back of the discs.**
- 5. Decorate the front of the disc with sequence, shiny wrapping paper or peel and stick gems or stickers.
(I used sequence and glossy wrapping paper cutouts in round shape in order to cover the center part of the disc. Peel and stick gems can be used too. In order to cut a small round shape you can use a water bottle or juice bottle lid to draw a circle.)**

6. Attach a loop on the top disc using tape.
