¹ HRC Bylaws, Article 3: Rules: The Commission by two thirds vote of its members may adopt bylaws governing the conduct of its meetings and activities, the establishment of subcommittees, and such other rules as may be necessary for the performance of its functions consistent with the City Charter, San Diego Municipal Code and any other applicable City regulation or policy.

Article 4: Subcommittees: The Chair may from time to time establish subcommittees, define their powers and duties, appoint a subcommittee chair, and appoint subcommittee members. The Chair of the Commission is an ex-officio member of every subcommittee. Generally, subcommittees will not have more than five (5) members.
