Complete a speaker form and give it to the Commission's Executive Director. California's open meeting laws don't permit the Commission to discuss or take any action on the matter at today's meeting. At its discretion, the Commission may refer the matter to staff or committee. Individual comments are limited to three minutes per speaker. At the discretion of the Chair, if a large number of people wish to speak on the same topic, comments may be limited to a set period of time.
