Virtual Testimony: Members of the public may provide comment on the comment period for Nonagenda Public Comment or Agenda Public Comment during the meeting, following the Public Comment Instructions:

Written Comment through webform: In lieu of in-person attendance, members of the public may submit their comments using the webform. If using the webform, indicate the agenda item number you wish to submit a comment for. Instructions for word limitations and deadlines are noted on the webform. On the webform, members of the public should select Human Relations Commission (even if the public comment is for a Human Relations Commission Committee meeting).

The public may attend a meeting when scheduled by following the attendee meeting link provided below. To view a meeting archive video, click here.

Only comments submitted no later than 4pm the day prior to the meeting using the public comment webform will be eligible to be read into the record. If you submit more than one comment on

webform per item, only one comment will be read into the record for that item. Comments received after 4pm the day prior and before 8am the day of the meeting will be provided to the Commission or Committee and posted online with the meeting materials. All comments are limited to 200 words. Comments received after 8am the day of the meeting, but before the item is called, will be submitted into the written record for the relevant item.

If you attach any documents to your comment, it will be distributed to the Commission or Committee in accordance with the deadlines described above.
