II. Non-Agenda Public Comment

No non-agenda public comment was received

III. Mayoral Update | Rita Fernandez, Immigrant Affairs Manager | Office of Mayor Kevin Faulconer

- Ms. Rita Fernandez presented an update on "Welcoming San Diego Strategic Plan on Immigrant and Refugee Integration 2019 2024"
- The creation of an Office of Immigrant Advancement is a formal recommendation of the strategic plan
- The Mayor's office has been vocal in its support for DACA, against the increase in fees for immigration applications, and in support of increased numbers of refugee resettlement, the approval of which is the responsibility of the County of San Diego
- The COVID-19 federal relief dollars that were made available by the CARES Act has not reached all immigrants, as only those with social security numbers are eligible to receive benefits
- The Trump administration's policy announcement stripping international college students of their U.S. visas if their coursework is entirely online is

- anticipated to adversely impact many immigrant students in the City of San Diego, and has received legal challenges from Harvard, MIT and other universities
- Ms. Rita Fernandez welcomes the International Affairs Board's assistance, particularly any ideas, guidance and perspectives that may help the Welcoming San Diego team implement its published goals

IV. Honorary Consular Update | David Pasquini, Consul | Government and Business Affairs - UK Government Office

- Mr. David Pasquini presented the following updates:
 - 1. On June 30, 2020 the San Diego Consular Corps held a virtual informal gathering of Honorary Consuls and guests, which was attended by members of the International Affairs Board, but future the organization of future meetings will require leadership from either members of San Diego's consular community or from the International Affairs Board
 - 2. Travel to and from the United Kingdom has been suspended out of San Diego International Airport, with only one regional flight departing each day from Los Angeles International Airport (travelers from the US to the UK are then required to undergo a 14-day quarantine period)
 - 3. The second round of trade talks between the UK and the US have just adjourned with the third round scheduled to complete later this month, and UK investment in San Diego remains an important element of our region's bilateral relationship with the UK

VI. Presentation by the World Trade Center | Lucas Coleman, Manager

- Mr. Lucas Coleman presented an update on the San Diego World Trade Center's update to its global economic development strategy titled "2025 Go Global Plan: Regional Trade and Investment Strategy"
- In 2015, the World Trade Center launched its original Go Global Plan with funding from JPMorgan Chase and advisement from the Brookings Institution
- Today, the World Trade Center is looking to take account of San Diego's progress against key performance indicators established during the 2015 Go Global Plan, with an eye toward informing the strategic recommendations that might be included in the 2025 Global Plan
- Mr. Lucas Coleman welcomes the International Affairs Board's participation in developing the 2025 Global Plan

- The benchmark study was intended to help the answer to the question, "where is the City of San Diego today" in order to better inform where the International Affairs Board decides to go next
