Intro – Chief's Introduction

- Human Factors A presentation concerning aspects of force science that pertain to an officer's ability to react in varying situations.
- High-Risk Vehicle Stops Participants get the opportunity to engage in high-risk vehicle stops.

 The scenario requires at least three volunteers. Participants encounter a non-cooperative suspect in which they have to determine how to take him into custody.
- K-9 Demonstration Participants get a brief session about the role of K-9 officers on the Department. That is followed by a scenario where a team of participants search for a suspect in an office with a K-9 officer and his dog.
- S.W.A.T Demonstration Participants receive the opportunity to look through the Department's Bearcat vehicle used by SWAT during missions. They also witnessed a demonstration of SWAT officers entering a location in a tactical manner. The participants get the chance to replicate the entry in the same manner as the SWAT officers.
- TASER Demonstration Participants receive a brief history lesson concerning the use of the TASER by the Department. After the lesson, participants get the opportunity to deploy the TASER at static targets.
- Force Option Simulator Participants engage in live-action/computer generated scenarios where they must decide if the use of force is necessary. Force options such as handguns, tasers, OC spray, and baton are available to use with the device.
