Dear Historic Resources Board:

The La Jolla Park Coastal Historic District nomination to the National Register is Item #3 on the Agenda of the July 27, 2023 meeting of the Historic Resources Board. On behalf of the Seal Conservancy, we have numerous unanswered questions regarding this pending nomination. In particular, we are concerned about how the new District, if approved, will impact the annual pupping season closure and the guideline rope at the Children's Pool / Casa Beach.

QUESTIONS

- 1. Are the existing Coastal Development Permits in compliance with the proposed La Jolla Park Coastal Historic District?
- 2. Is the proposed La Jolla Park Coastal Historic District harmonized with the California Coastal Act? If not, how and by whom will policy conflicts be resolved?
- 3. Will future Coastal Development Permit renewals trigger CEQA?
- 4. Will future Coastal Development Permit renewals require individual EIR's?
- 5. Will the City of San Diego be required to remove the guideline rope, currently authorized from May 15 to December 15 annually as per CDP's 6-15-0223 and 6-15-0223-A2?
- 6. Will the City of San Diego be required to terminate the annual pupping season closure, currently authorized from December 15 to May 15 annually as per CDP's 6-14-0691 and 6-14-0691-A1?

Please provide answers to the above questions.
