

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Continued Parking Removal and Lane Reduction on  
Custer Street**

January 10, 2023

Custer Street will continue to be reduced to one southbound lane and parking removals will remain in effect from Sherman Street to Greenwood Street as crews construct the City of San Diego Morena Pump Station project, part of the Pure Water San Diego Program.

**What To Expect:** Construction crews will continue on-site construction of the Morena Pump Station on Custer Street between Sherman Street and Friars Road. As a result, ***parking removals and lane reductions will continue to be in place on Custer Street through the remainder of the project. Construction crews will maintain access to driveways and one lane of southbound traffic will remain open at all times.*** All nearby businesses will remain open and accessible. Southbound traffic on Custer Street will be directed to continue on Greenwood Street, a one-way City of San Diego easement road. Construction vehicles may use Greenwood Street for deliveries and/or access to the construction site. Please follow posted signage and crew member directions near the work zone.

**When:** Parking removals and lane reduction in place on Custer Street started Monday, July 18, 2022 and will be in effect through the duration of the Morena Pump Station project construction. The work is scheduled for Monday to Friday during the daytime hours, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

**Why:** Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Pump Station project is one of several major water infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on [morena.purewatersd.org](http://morena.purewatersd.org).
