COVID-19 PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING REDISTRICTING COMMISSION MEETING ACCESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Until further notice, meetings will be conducted pursuant to the provisions of California Government Code section 54953(e), added by Assembly Bill 361, which allows the Commission to use teleconferencing and to provide the public an opportunity to address the Commission via a call-in option or an internet-based service option, during a proclaimed state of emergency when measures to promote social distancing are in effect or the Commission has determined meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.

During the current State of Emergency and in the interest of public health and safety, all members of the Redistricting Commission will be participating in meetings by teleconference. In accordance with the Executive Order, there will be no members of the public in attendance at the meetings. We are providing alternatives to in-person attendance for viewing and participating in meetings.

Comments received after the start of the meeting but before the item is called will be submitted into the written record for the relevant item.

Non-Agenda Public Comment may be submitted using the [webform](#), checking the appropriate box. Comments received by the start of the meeting will be distributed to the Commission and posted online with the meeting materials. All webform comments are limited to 200 words. Comments received after the start of the meeting but before Non-agenda comment is called will be submitted into the written record for the meeting.

If you wish to submit written materials for submission into the record or have an attachment to your comment, you may email it to Redistricting2020@sandiego.gov or submit via U.S. Mail 202 C Street, MS8A, San Diego, CA 92101. Materials submitted via e-mail will be distributed to the Commission in accordance with the deadlines described above. Materials submitted via U.S. Mail will need to be received the business day prior in order for it to be distributed to the Commission.
