

## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Traffic and Parking Closure from July 17-July 28**

July 12, 2023

From Monday, July 17, through Friday, July 28, Greenwood Street will be closed to all vehicle traffic and parking from Custer Street through Banks Street for the City of San Diego Morena Pump Station project, part of the Pure Water San Diego Program. Additionally, Custer Street will be closed to vehicle traffic from the start of the concrete barrier (k-rail), located midway down the street, to Greenwood Street.

**What To Expect:** Construction crews will be installing conduit for a permanent power supply for the Morena Pump Station. Greenwood Street, a one-way City of San Diego easement road, will be closed to all vehicle traffic and parking to accommodate construction activities. Additionally, Custer Street will be closed to vehicle traffic from the start of the concrete barrier (k-rail), located midway down the street, to Greenwood Street. Follow posted signage and crew member directions near the work zone. Access to businesses located within the closed section of Custer Street will be maintained via Banks Street. Parking will be available on Sherman Street, and the sidewalk on Custer Street will remain open for pedestrians. Please see page 2 for a map of the closure area.

**When:** The traffic and parking closures on Greenwood Street and Custer Street will start on Monday, July 17, and will continue through Friday, July 28. The closures will be in effect day and night for the duration of the work.

**Why:** Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Pump Station project is one of several major water infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on [morena.purewatersd.org](https://www.morena.purewatersd.org).
