

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Nighttime Full Road Closures on Friars Road between Sea World Drive and Napa Street from June 18-30

Jun. 13, 2023

From Sunday, June 18, through Friday, June 30, construction crews will be working during the nighttime on Friars Road for the City of San Diego Morena Pump Station project, part of the Pure Water San Diego Program. During the nighttime work, Friars Road will be fully closed to all vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian traffic between Sea World Drive and Napa Street as crews install conduit. Work and closure hours are Sunday through Thursday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. During the day, one eastbound lane and two-way bicycle traffic will be open on Friars Road between Sea World Drive and Napa Street.

What To Expect: During nighttime work, a full closure of Friars Road will be in effect between Sea World Drive and Napa Street while construction crews install conduit by trenching, placing the conduit, and soil backfilling. Noise and light impacts are expected in the area, however; crews are aware of nearby residences and will minimize impacts to the extent possible. During the day, Friars Road between Sea World Drive and Napa Street will reopen to eastbound traffic only and two-way bicycle traffic.

When: Nighttime full closures of Friars Road will occur from Sunday, June 18, 2023 to Friday, June 30, 2023. The work and the closures are scheduled for Sunday to Thursday nights, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change due to weather impacts, site conditions and operational issues.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Pump Station project is one of several major water infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on [morena.purewatersd.org](https://www.morena.purewatersd.org).
