

'California's first highway,' originally Fr. Junipero Serra's wagon road to connect his string of missions up the California coastline in the late 1700s, and for nearly two centuries the principal north-south route in California.

San Diego's section, named 'Pacific Highway,' was an important transportation link between manufacturing plants and the nearby airfields for launching thousands of new airplanes during World War II.


Automotive transportation and aeronautical themes are both suggested by Historic 101 signage, wayfinding, interpretive displays, and streetscape components.




Trail Location
