

# La Playa Trail

In use by Native Americans long before the Spanish arrival in 1769, the La Playa Trail is considered the oldest commercial trail west of the Mississippi.

It stretches from the entrance to San Diego Harbor, our original port known as 'La Playa,' to the Mission San Diego de Alcalá, and beyond.

Signage and other streetscape elements will express this historical relationship through traditional materials (adobe, wrought iron, timber, etc), colors, artisanal workmanship and interpretive signage.
