## AGENDA ITEMS

Michael Freedman opened the meeting at 6:15 and turned it over to Jami Williams, with RRM Design Group. The first topic on the agenda was a presentation by Jami. She provided an overview of where we are in the update process and focused on gathering data related to **Urban Design and Distinct Neighborhoods**. RRM presented new neighborhood boundaries and asked for feedback. The community wanted time to review the information and suggest comments.

The **Urban Design Character Exercise** took about 45 minutes. The audience split into four tables and ranked preferences for four urban design topics including Massing & Scale, Architectural Style, Frontages and Gateways.
