ALCOHOL LICENSING & NEIGHBORHOOD CODE ENFORCEMENT:

Action Item

Roundtable discussion continuing the conversation started at the Planning Commission’s March 13 workshop. Planning Commission will schedule another meeting to recommend changing the Municipal Code, Council Resolution R-294124, public noticing, standard conditions on Alcohol CUPs, and/or regulation of existing businesses. Opportunity for CPC to weigh in early in this process; consider forming an ad hoc committee to study the issues in depth and bring back recommendations to CPC in April. Discussion and public comment will be limited to current permitting, processes, enforcement, and working towards development of solutions. *There will be no staff presentation; public comment limited to individual 2 minutes each.*
