**Prohibition of Parking of Oversized Vehicles and Non-Motorized
Vehicles Proposed Ordinance**

- Prohibition of parking of oversized and non-motorized vehicles on any street for a period longer than four (4) hours.
- Prohibition of parking of oversized and non-motorized vehicles on any street between the hours of 2 AM and 6 AM of any day.
- Prohibition of parking of oversized and non-motorized vehicles within 50 feet of any intersection.
- Exceptions:
 - a) pick ups and deliveries
 - b) emergencies
 - c) government and public utility vehicles
 - d) school buses involved in the transportation of students
 - e) buses used for the transportation of youths or disabled persons during the course of a designated activity.
- Noticing program.
- Definitions:
 - a) Oversized vehicle means any vehicle that exceeds 22 feet in length or 80 inches in height (including any attached trailers, vehicles or loads thereon).
 - b) Non-Motorized Vehicle means any trailer or trailer bus, as defined in Vehicle Code Sections 636 and 550 and any recreational vehicle.
 - c) A recreational vehicle means:
 - i. Any camp trailer, camper, trailer coach, or house car, as defined in Vehicle Code sections 242, 243 and 635 or California Health and Safety Code section 18010;
 - ii. Boats, boat trailers, dune buggies, and other motorized or towed vehicles used solely for recreational purposes.
