Background: The City Planning Department is requiring all CPGs to update their Bylaws based on the recent City Council approval of amendments to Council Policy 600-24 and the Bylaws Shell. The revised 600-24 document became effective as of November 14, 2014. Betsy McCullough, with the City Planning Department, has emailed a draft copy of MRN bylaws with minor changes, made a few requests for input and requested that MRN review and the election policies and procedures. Discussion on the bylaws occurred at the Tuesday, February 2, 2015 meeting. At the Feb 2nd meeting, members were in agreement to reduce, the planning group size from 20 to 16. At this time, it's probable that the bylaw amendments can be approved administratively by staff and the City Attorney. The subcommittee will work to prepare a bylaw revision for recommendation at either the March or May meeting.
