- 1. Adoption of draft agenda. Added 3 (c), moved 5 (b) to reports. Deleted 6 (a). Motion to approve draft agenda with these changes made/seconded by Bruce Brown/Joe Frichtel: Motion carried 11/0/0.
- 2. Approval of prior meeting minutes: Motion to approve October and November 2009 Meeting Minutes made/seconded by Erwin Rose/Bruce Brown. Motion carried 8/0/3.

 - i. Ground-breaking for military cemetery extension of Ft. Rosecrans at Miramar.

- c. CalTrans Transportation Grant. A letter expressing initial general interest was sent. Linda sent to the City an initial concept for Environmental Justice Grant for East Miramar. A motion was made/seconded by Bruce Brown/Erwin Rose to make this information item an action item to consider Linda's draft proposal for this grant as the official MMCPG proposal. Motion carried unanimously.
- d. Linda presented details of the draft proposal for the grant application.

 Motion was made/seconded by Bruce Brown/John Brand to accept the draft proposal as the official proposal of the MMCPG for the grant application.

- b. Clearwire Telcomm Sites Program: Anne Wolftange
 - i. Partner w/Sprint to create 4G network. 4X faster than 3G.
 - ii. 6 microwave sites proposed in the Mira Mesa area. Ms. Wolftange presented design and pictures showing the appearance. Full documentation with pictures and maps is available by hyperlink at http://miramesatowncouncil.org/planning_group.htm The six locations are:
 - 1. Grace Church on Mira Mesa Blvd.
 - 2. (Sprint) Del Campo Court. (San Diego Ice Arena)
 - 3. Mesa Verde Park
 - 4. (Sprint) Maddox Park
 - a. Study was not done taking into account the new Jonas Salk Public School. Clearwire needs to get with SDUSD to make sure their "line of sight" microwave transmission is not affected by the school construction.
 - 5. Mesa Viking Park
 - a. Similar to Mesa Verde.
 - b. Steve Esquilin expressed interest in better lighting on the West end of the park, but the nearby trees would

likely obstruct the signal.

- 6. Lopez Ridge Park
 - a. Residents express concern about intrusive lighting. These new antennae will not involve a change in lighting.
- iii. City must follow Federal guidelines. Radio Frequency (RF) studies will be ordered on each to examine project against Federal guidelines. Community may request on-air study after installation to make sure it works as it was designed/presented.
- iv. These sites are on the agenda for information. They will be on agenda for voting in February. MMCPG will vote for each site separately. City had many questions/issues and Clearwire is in the process of addressing the issues.
- v. Q1 of 2011 is expected completion date.
- c. Alexandria Tech Center Sorrento View: Michael L. Asaro, AIA, LEED AP of Delawie Wilkes Rodriguez Barker. Third assessment letter is posted at http://miramesatowncouncil.org/planning_group.htm (Information)
 - i. Original project was for life sciences, but projections did not support this market.
 - ii. Design revised to match activity in the area.
 - iii. Design revised to 20% less floor space, but the same amount of parking.
 - iv. Same traffic impact with mitigation steps in place.
- d. Los Peñasquitos Canyon Preserve Citizens Advisory Committee.

Appendix 1: CalTrans Update

Upcoming Closures/Traffic Shifts: I-15 Express Lanes South Segment

Introduction:

My name is Kara Palmer and I'm part of the outreach team on this project. I'll be working onsite, as Antoinette Meier has taken a position at SANDAG. Debbie Lowery Cunning is here with me tonight. She is also part of the outreach team. I can be reached at the same office and cell phone numbers and I am temporarily using Mariemail address until I have a Caltrans account established. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.

Construction Outlook:

Construction in the Miramar area is primarily focused on work in the median to add the two new Express Lanes.

Both Poway Road/Rancho Penasquitos Blvd. Bridge and Carroll Canyon Road Bridge are on track for completion in 2011. The north side of Poway Road/Rancho Penasquitos Blvd Bridge should be finished in early spring 2010 and the demolition and reconstruction on the south side of the bridge should begin in spring/early summer 2010. Reconstruction of the south side of Carroll Canyon Road bridge should be complete mid-2010 and construction on the north side should begin shortly thereafter.

U3S - SR-56/Ted Williams Parkway to just north of Mira Mesa Blvd.

- We do not have any foreseen extended ramp closures in the immediate future. Some work will still require some regularly nighttime closures.
- Rancho Peñasquitos Blvd/Poway Road Bridge work:
 - We will be pouring concrete on the Poway Road/Rancho Penasquitos Blvd. bridge next Tuesday, 1/26, weather permitting. This will require a full NB freeway closure from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.

(Detour if asked: Motorists traveling north on I-15 will be detoured to east on Poway Road to north on Sabre Springs Parkway to west on Ted Williams Parkway onto northbound I-15).

 Surface streets over bridge will also be closed during this work beginning at 8 p.m. and reopening at 5 a.m.

(Detour if asked: Motorists traveling west on Poway Road will be detoured onto northbound I-15 to west on Ted Williams Parkway to south on I-15 onto westbound Rancho Peñasquitos Boulevard. Motorists traveling east on Rancho Peñasquitos Boulevard will be detoured south on I-15 to east on Mercy Road to north on I-15 onto eastbound Poway Road. Detour signs will be in place to direct motorists).

 Traffic should be shifted to the outside of the freeway likely in spring/early summer 2010.

U2S - Just north of Mira Mesa Blvd to Miramar Road

- Upcoming traffic shift to the outside of the SB general purpose lanes
 - Will likely occur in early to mid-February
 - Traffic shift will allow crews to begin working on the median of the freeway on the new Express Lanes and also allow them to continue work on Carroll Canyon Road bridge.
 - No major closure needed. Will restripe general purpose lanes in one night, maybe two.
 - Traffic shift on NB side will occur in early to mid-2010.
- Considering creating two lane temporary on-ramp from WB Mira Mesa Blvd to SB I-15 to help relieve Carroll Canyon Road congestion.
 - Our Caltrans construction team is considering an extended closure to complete a new ramp alignment. As an interim traffic management measure, we are considering adding an additional single occupant vehicle lane to the WB on-ramp to SB I-15. This will allow a temporary two lane on-ramp.

U1S - Miramar Road to SR-163/SR-52

 Upcoming 4 night southbound general purpose lane closure from just south of Miramar Way to past the spilt

- Likely will be the end of the first week or second week in February.

 Friday Monday night. Waiting for contractor to confirm dates to be sure.
- Needed to install overhead signage
- All southbound general purpose lane traffic will be detoured into the Express Lanes just south of Miramar Way using a temporary onramp.
- Traffic to exit back into general purpose lanes just after the split on either I-15 or SR-163.
