1. Call to Order/Introduction of Members: Meeting was called to order at 6:33 p.m. by Daniel Wagner, Chair, at the Otay Mesa Branch Library. He welcomed all Board members and the community to the meeting of the Otay Mesa-Nestor Community Planning Group (OMNCPG).
2. Approval of minutes – Motion by Diego Padilla to approve the minutes of January 13, 2009 as amended, the motion was passed unanimously.
3. Non-Agenda Public Comments:
  - A. Diane Porter – said she is working with the City of San Diego traffic engineer, council office and the park ranger, and is discussing ways to slow street traffic down in Hollister/Leon/Saturn area.
4. Council District 8 Report: Whitney Benzian requested that planning group members call and email him at his office during the month with questions or concerns. He said that auto waste recycling events are scheduled soon on the South Bay area, and that flyers are available at the meeting. He announced that by dialing 211, you can be linked to someone who will assess your needs, and then match you to the best resource in your community. The service is offered in more than 150 languages. He also said that the restroom facilities at the Montgomery-Waller Recreation Center will soon be built.
5. Action by Chairman: In response to concerns from OMCPG members, Chairman Wagner formed a sub-committee to focus on traffic and traffic calming methods. Myrna Briggs will chair the sub-committee, with Diane Porter and Maria Mendoza serving on it.
6. SDPD Community Relations: Officer MacTiernan introduced Albert Guaderrama, who is now Captain of the Southern Division of the San Diego Police Department. Captain Guaderrama said that this is the first time he has worked in this area with the Police Department, and that he is pleased to serve. He announced that due to her excellent work, Officer MacTiernan will be transferred soon to vice. He said another officer will be appointed to serve the OMNCPG area as the Police Department community relations contact.
7. Chair's Report: Daniel Wagner said that he has received a notice of application for environmental permits for the City of San Diego Storm Water System Maintenance Program. Copies of the environmental document are

available. He also said that a City of San Diego Wireless Task Force is soliciting input from community members. He also said that the Medical Marijuana Task Force will be attending the March, 2010 meeting of the OMNCPG to make a presentation, and to receive input from members.

7. Long Range City Planner's Report: No report.
8. Other Business/Announcements: Vinnie Thoms announced that the City of San Diego will be presenting a workshop, which will be held on February 25, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The workshop is titled "What to Know About Renewing Projects."
