  - b. He said that National Night Out at the Robert Egger Senior South Bay Recreation Center was a success, and about 600 people attended.
  - c. He also said that the crime rate continues to go down.

The OMCPG Project Development Sub-Committee has reviewed the project, and reported that this project will not affect the adjacent Multiple Species Conservation Program area, and they recommend approval.
