1. **Call to Order/Introduction of Members:** The meeting was called to order at 6:31 p.m. by Vice Chair Jacki Farrington, at the Otay Mesa Nestor Branch Library. She welcomed all Board members and members of the community to the meeting of the Otay Mesa - Nestor Community Planning Group (OMNCPG).
2. **Approval of minutes** – A motion was made by Bob Mikloski to approve the minutes of the August, 2015, OMNCPG Meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
3. **Non-Agenda Public Comments:**
 - a. Brian McGonagill said that streets that Route 901 takes has been changed by the MTS due to complaints about noise by two people.
 - b. Walt Zumstein said that he attended the recent utilities undergrounding meeting, and said that the project will impact traffic.
4. **SDPD Community Relations:** Officer Carlos Lacarra, clacarra@pd.sandiego.gov (619) 424-0440.
 - a. Officer Lacarra gave the following report:
 1. The Light The Night event will be held October 24th at Balboa Park, he said that you can donate through their website: <http://sdcrimestoppers.org/light-the-night-against-crime/>
 2. 294 vehicles passed through a recent DUI checkpoint, resulting in 6 arrests.
 3. City-wide SDPD statistics were released for April, May and June 2015:
 - a. Robberies up 38%
 - b. Residential burglaries up 6%
 - c. Commercial burglaries down 60%
 - d. Thefts up 20%

- e. Stolen vehicles down 9%.
 4. He said that the SDPD is working hard to keep the community safe.
 5. He reported that on 9/6/15, in the 3000 block of Blando Dr., there was a domestic violence call, the suspect said he had a knife, suspect was taken into custody on spousal battery charges.
 6. He also said that on 9/8/15, in the 2800 block of Arbordar, there was a domestic violence rape, the suspect locked the female out of the house, took 2 kids hostage, would not come out. SWAT was called, and the suspect eventually surrendered.

- a. She announced that there will be slurry street sealing soon in District 8, and handed out a map of the streets where this work will be done.
 - b. She gave a brief report why the 901 bus route was recently changed, and said the MTS looked at several factors, such as: avoiding delays due to the trolley crossing on 27th Street, total ridership counts, etc., when they made the final decision to reroute the 901 bus.
 - c. She said that the Otay Mesa Nestor Library building is currently under study for needed repairs to the building's structure.
