Over the past several months, the project team has conducted field investigations, researched existing conditions and reviewed planning documents to develop recommended improvements for the seven communities included in Phase 4 of the Master Plan:

- Kensington/Talmadge
- Midway/Pacific Highway
- Old San Diego

- Ocean Beach
- Pacific Beach
- San Ysidro
