AIRPORTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE VACANCIES

October 10, 2012

The City of San Diego Airports Advisory Committee (AAC) advises the Mayor on issues that affect the City's two general aviation airports, Montgomery and Brown Field Airports. The Committee is composed of twelve members who represent aviation tenants and users at each airport, and community planning groups in the vicinity of the airports. Three of the members have special expertise that could benefit the Committee.

The Committee normally meets on the second Tuesday of each month at 3 P.M. at Montgomery Field, with one meeting per year at Brown Field. Members are appointed by the Mayor and serve four year terms.

There are currently two vacancies on the Committee: one representing **Brown Field tenants**, and one representing the **Clairemont Mesa Community**. If you belong to one of these groups, and have an interest in serving on the Committee, or know someone who might be interested, please submit a letter of interest and statement of qualifications by November 30, 2012 to:
