Workshops will be held at the following locations:

Funding through the CCSD program is available to nonprofit organizations that produce arts and culture or community-building events. Typical projects include community arts activities, such as theatrical productions or visual art exhibits, parades, and festivals. The organizations receiving funds are regarded as “contractors.” Amounts of contracts are based on the size of the project budget.

Fiscal year 2008 contracts for service ranged from \$5,000 to \$30,000.

Projects must occur between July 1, 2008 and June 30, 2009. Determining the amounts each organization will receive is a competitive process. Complete applications must be received in the Commission’s office or postmarked by October 19, 2007. Applications will then be reviewed and scored by a panel of experts. The purpose of these workshops is to help applicants prepare the best possible application.
