The AAP is the yearly update to the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and consists of the activities to be funded through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA).

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of San Diego's Draft FY 2013 AAP is available for a 30-day public review from April 10 through May 9, 2012. The purpose of the review is to provide the public with an opportunity to comment on the planned expenditures of approximately \$23 million in federal entitlement funds. The draft document will be available in the reference section of all City of San Diego libraries and at the CDBG Program office located at 1200 Third Avenue, Suite 1400, San Diego, CA 92101.
