



**TO RESPOND TO Q 3A**

***Need LMI % for CDBG – eligible census tracts***

1: Identify 2000 Census Tract(s) affected by project

Go to SANDAG's Geographic Boundary Viewer:





2. Place cursor over “Geographic Boundary Layers”
3. Choose “Census Tracts and Zip Code”
4. Click on arrow pointing downwards to expand the category
5. Choose “Census Tracts 2000” to activate the layer




8. Click on census tract of interest to get census tract number








6. A window opens identifying census tract number



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## QUALIFIED CENSUS TRACTS

The 2013 Qualified Census Tracts (QCTs) are effective beginning January 1, 2013. The 2013 designation uses data from the 2010 Decennial Census and the 2006 to 2010 American Community Survey (ACS) 5-year tabulations. The 2012 designations for American Samoa, Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, and the U.S. Virgin Islands will remain in effect because data from the 2010 Decennial Census is not available for these areas.
