GENERAL INFORMATION

Under San Diego Municipal Code §22.3004(a), any contractor desiring to bid as a prime contractor for City of San Diego public works projects must be prequalified for financial resources, technical qualifications; experience; material, equipment, and expertise necessary to carry out the work; a satisfactory record of performance; and a satisfactory record of compliance with applicable statutes and regulations. This questionnaire covers a contractor who intends to bid as a prime contractor only on contracts valued at \$1,000,000 or less. Prequalification is effective for two (2) years from the date of the initial approval letter and is renewable every two (2) years thereafter.

The prequalification program packet consists of the following required submittals:

1. Complete and accurate answers to the questions in the Prequalification Program Questionnaire for Small Projects
2. Current and complete annual financial statement
3. Current original bond letter

These documents are used as the basis for rating prime contractors with respect to the size and scope of contracts which contractors are qualified to bid. The City of San Diego reserves the right to check other available sources. Omission of requested information can result in automatic disqualification.

The prequalification program documents are not public records, subject to the Public Records Act, and are not open for public inspection. All information provided will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. The City of San Diego reserves the right to reject any and all program questionnaires and to waive any irregularities in the information contained therein.

Each program questionnaire, and any other submitted pages, must be signed under penalty of perjury by an individual who has the legal authority to bind the contractor on whose behalf that person is signing. If any information provided by a contractor changes, the contractor must immediately notify the City of San Diego and provide updated, accurate information in writing and under penalty of perjury.

The completed prequalification program packet, consisting of the Prequalification Program Questionnaire for Small Projects, current bond letter and current financial statement must be sent to:

NOTE: A complete prequalification program package must be received at least ten (10) business days prior to any bid opening that the prime contractor wishes to bid on to allow time for review, verification and approval.

 - Balance Sheet
 - Statement of Income and Retained Earnings
 - Statement of Cash Flows

3. Bond Letter:
 - Dollar amount for a single contract
 - Dollar amount for an aggregate program
 - Original addressed to the City of San Diego
 - Notarized with Power of Attorney
