

What is the Coastal Rail Trail?

- A Regional system of multi-use paths and bikeways
- Connects Oceanside, Carlsbad, Encinitas, Solana Beach, Del Mar, and San Diego
- Current City project segment has potential to create several miles of different kinds of bikeways between Carmel Valley Road to Gilman Drive at I-5
- Current project will connect employment and residential centers in Sorrento Valley and UTC, UCSD to other regional destinations and bikeways


