City of San Diego seeks comments on Coastal Rail Trail Project *Public workshop will focus on alternative alignments.*

SAN DIEGO, CA (May 22, 2013) – The City of San Diego will host a public workshop to seek input on the regional bike Coastal Rail Trail (CRT) Project. The public is encouraged to attend the workshop to learn about the CRT and offer comments on alternative alignments to be considered.

The workshop is open to the public and comments and input provided will help identify the range of alternatives for further study. Based on the results of the study of the public input received at the workshop, a preferred alternative will be selected.

WHY:

The CRT project features:

- A multi-use trail to better connect the coastal cities of Oceanside, Del Mar, Carlsbad, Encinitas, Solana Beach and San Diego
- A viable bicycle route for commuters and multi-use trails that will serve as a community asset for walkers, joggers and recreational cyclists
- Important connections between regional employment centers in Sorrento Valley, UCSD, and University City, residential communities to the north and south, COASTER stations and a future Trolley line in the project area
- Efforts to increase mobility, reduce greenhouse gases, improve public health, and enhance the quality of life
