Water Group Job 3012 Pacific Beach

Background

Water Group Job 3012 is part of a program established by the City of San Diego and the Department of Public Health mandating the replacement of all aging and deteriorating cast iron water mains. Some of the mains in Pacific Beach to be replaced by this project date back to 1933. The replacement of these aging pipes will increase service reliability and minimize future water main breaks.

Project Overview

Water Group Job 3012 will replace nearly eight miles of existing cast iron water mains via open trench with new eight inch (8") and twelve inch (12") pipes within the City's right of way. The project also includes curb ramp installation and street resurfacing.

There may be temporary water outages while City crews make cuts or connections to the existing main. Residents and businesses within 300 feet of the project will be promptly notified prior to this work. To minimize the inconvenience during construction, residents and businesses along the alignment of the new main will be placed on a temporary highline, which is a two inch (2") above ground main that will service impacted residences while the new main is being installed.

Construction Schedule

Construction is scheduled to start in the summer of 2010 and is estimated to complete by summer of 2013. Construction of this project will occur in several phases over a three-year period in order to minimize the impact to residents, visitors and students. Traffic flow will be allowed during the hours of construction. At the end of each day, the entire street will be reopened to normal traffic conditions.

The project includes portions of the following streets: Crown Point Dr, Sequoia St, Jewell St, Promontory St, Lamont St, Pacific Beach Dr, Oliver Ave, Cass St, Thomas Ave, Garnet Ave, Hornblend St, Fanuel St, Diamond St, Windsor Dr, Kendall St, Balboa Ave, Donaldson Dr, Beryl St, Turquoise St, Los Altos Court, Loring St, Malden St, Wilbur Ave, Academy St, Emerald St, Felspar St, Fogg St and Gresham St.

Cost

The cost of this project is approximately \$10,438,458
