SUBJECT : Appointment to the Balboa Park Committee

It is my pleasure to appoint Scott Glazebrook to Balboa Park Committee, subject to your confirmation.

Scott Glazebrook is the Founder and Owner of Open Architecture Workshop, an architecture and environmental design firm in San Diego. He based the company on the concept of technology-based open design combined with classic architecture and the belief that the result can have a positive and uplifting impact on the community and environment. Local projects include Influx Café Plumbing Design, Sushi Performance and Visual Arts and craftsman-style remodels. He founded Open Architecture Workshop in 2007. Mr. Glazebrook is also an Adjunct Faculty Instructor for Environmental Systems at the School of Architecture and Design, Woodbury University.

Prior to his current positions, Mr. Glazebrook worked as Director of Architecture at MW Steele Group, Inc. He began as a Project Manager and Designer in 1999, advancing to Associate in 2002 and Principal in 2006. Projects included UCSD Faculty Club Addition and Coronado Public Library Expansion and Renovation. Mr. Glazebrook also worked for a variety of other architectural firms in San Diego, San Francisco and San Antonio.

Membership and community involvement include American Institute of Architects (AIA), Architecture 2030, Habitat for Humanity and San Diego Green Organizing Committee. He has been a member of the Greater Golden Hill Planning Committee since 2004 and has served on numerous subcommittees during his tenure.

Mr. Glazebrook received his Bachelor of Arts in Liberal Studies with emphasis in Urban Geography, City Planning and Environmental Design from San Diego State University. He holds a Master of Architecture from the University of Texas at Austin. He is a licensed architect in the State of California and is a LEED Accredited Professional through the U.S. Green Building Council.
