SUBJECT : Appointments to the Consolidated Plan Advisory Board

It is my pleasure to appoint Aaron Friberg, William Moore, and Jennifer Litwak to the Consolidated Plan Advisory Board, subject to your confirmation.

Aaron Friberg has been an active member of the San Diego community for more than ten years. He served on his church's Board of Directors for four years, during which time he led the church's multi-ethnic youth group, comprised of students from the Latino, Sudanese and Cambodian communities, with energy, compassion and creativity. He also frequently participated in his church's weekly feeding of the homeless in downtown San Diego.

After graduating from Point Loma Nazarene University, Mr. Friberg attended UCLA School of Law where he served as managing editor of the UCLA Law Review. He is an active member of the Lawyers Club and the San Diego branch of the American Constitution Society. Mr. Friberg is an attorney at Latham & Watkins LLP in the firm's finance department and specializes in financing energy and hospitality-related projects all over the world. He was nominated by Councilmember David Alvarez.

William Moore is the owner of The Moore Firm, a business law firm specializing in legal issues pertaining to entrepreneurs and businesses. He is an active member of the California and Georgia State Bars, and has been a proud member of the La Jolla Golden Triangle Rotary Club since 2008.

Mr. Moore is a director of the San Diego Lawyer Chapter of the American Constitution Society, and was honored by the Urban League of San Diego as a Top 40 Leader Under 40 in 2010. A

native of Macon, Georgia, Mr. Moore earned his Bachelor's degree from Georgia Tech in 1996. After volunteering in the Peace Corps in Tambacounda, Senegal, he returned to the U.S. and earned a Juris Doctorate from Columbia Law School in 2002. He was nominated by Councilmember Sherri Lightner.


Jennifer Litwak began working at the Regional Task Force on the Homeless in November 2010 as the Manager of Projects and Development. In her short tenure at the Task Force, she coordinated the county-wide collection and analysis of demographic data from the county's homeless population and has authored numerous statistical reports detailing the outcomes of the analysis to stakeholders including; homeless service providers, San Diego City and County elected officials and the U.S. Housing and Urban Development. Professionally, Ms. Litwak Chairs the Legislative Advocacy Committee of the Emergency Resources Group, which collects, shares and tracks information on pertinent legislation that effects homeless individuals and those who serve them. Prior to her work at the Regional Task Force on the Homeless, Ms. Litwak practiced civil and business litigation at Simone & Roos in Los Angeles, California.

Ms. Litwak has complemented her professional career with extensive community service. She serves as a Board Member for the North Park Redevelopment Project Area Committee and Chairs the Multifamily Housing Enhancement Loan Program Committee. Ms. Litwak is a member of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee. She is a member of Congregation Beth Israel and participates in the Israel Committee and Social Action Committee.

Ms. Litwak has a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology with a minor in Political Science from Wake Forest University where she graduated *Magna Cum Laude*. She also holds a Juris Doctor from the University of Denver Sturm College of Law and was a recipient of the post-graduate Dean's Graduate Research Fellowship. She was nominated by Council President Pro Temp Kevin Faulconer.
