



It is with great pleasure that I nominate Anne Fege for reappointment to the Community Forest Advisory Board.

Ms. Fege currently serves as the Community Forest Advisory Board Chair. During her tenure, the Board completed "Urban Forest Management Plan Background and Current Conditions," a report that helps guide the City in making decisions to reinvest in living assets. She has been a strong advocate of the urban forestry program, working to secure budgetary resources for the maintenance and preservation of the city's trees. She has also been a strong advocate for inclusion of a tree inventory count in the city's first-ever sidewalk condition assessment.
