SUBJECT : Reappointments to the Human Relations Commission

It is my pleasure to reappoint Mary Alcock, Mitz Lee, Gracia Molina de Pick, Mark Dillon, Carolina Ramos and George Mitrovich to the Human Relations Commission, subject to City Council confirmation.

Mary Alcock has served two years on the Commission and is the representative from District 2. She resides in Point Loma.

Mitz Lee was initially appointed last year as the District 5 representative. She resides in Mira Mesa.

Gracia Molina de Pick was appointed to represent District 8 in 2008 and resides in La Jolla.

Mark Dillon, Carolina Ramos and George Mitrovich were all Mayoral selections. Mr. Dillon and Ms. Ramos have served since 2007, while Mr. Mitrovich began his service earlier this year. Mr. Dillon resides Poway, Ms. Ramos resides in Southcrest and Mr. Mitrovich resides in Kensington.

The Human Relations Commission consults and reports to the Mayor and City Council about the rights of all inhabitants within the city to equal economic, political and educational opportunity; to equal accommodations in all business establishments in the city and; to equal service and protection by public agencies.

I ask that you confirm these reappointments and join me in thanking these individuals for their willingness to continue serving the City of San Diego in this capacity.
