SUBJECT : Appointment & Reappointments to the La Jolla Shores Planned District Advisory Board

It is my pleasure to appoint Susan S. Starr and reappoint Suzanne Weissman, Dan Goese, and Jane Potter to the La Jolla Shores Planned District Advisory Board, subject to your confirmation.

Susan Starr has been Editor of the Journal of the Medical Library Association since May of 2008. Prior to her retirement in July 2007, she was Director of the Biomedical Library in San Diego and Associate University Librarian for the Sciences at the University of California, San Diego. She most recently served as the Interim Associate Dean of the Library at California State University, San Marcos. Dr. Starr spent most of her professional career at UC San Diego, where she occupied a variety of positions. She also worked at the UC Office of the President as one of the team that founded the California Digital Library. Since retiring, she has become a Docent at San Diego Botanic Gardens and is actively involved in the La Jolla Village Garden Club. Susan is also a quilter and serves as Treasurer of the Seaside Quilters Guild.

The La Jolla Shores Planned District Advisory Board reviews all applications for permits referred to it including applications for Planned Residential Developments (PRD's) within La Jolla Shores Planned District and to submit its recommendations or comments on these matters in writing within 30 days to Planning Director. They also recommend to Planning Commission any changes to regulations, provided such changes are necessary for proper execution of adopted plan, and to adopt rules of procedure to supplement those contained within this division.
