I live in City Heights and so have been able to become very familiar with all types of cultures. I am disabled and have experience working for equality for those with disabilities.

This wide exposure to different cultures and my ability to work with them will be an extremely important asset as the Commission works to create a fair and balanced approach.

I offer a working knowledge of what is required. I am familiar with how Boards and Committees work, Roberts Rules, the Brown Act and the other regulations. I have been working in and around government and its culture for 15 years. I have sat on many boards, committees and working groups.

I was one of the very few people who regularly attended the Redistricting Commission meetings for the 2000 session, and was an integral part of that process. My comments and suggestions were an integral part of the final map.

I have the time available to put my full support into the work of the Commission. It has been commented by many council members that they always appreciate my comments on issues because they are well researched, to the point and informative. I can bring those same traits to this commission. That will be important for an issue that has so many diverse positions to consider in its deliberations.
